Dear Participant and Parents:

On behalf of the Rotary Club of Ottawa, I welcome your interest in participating in the Rotary Adventure in Citizenship Program. The program will take place April 26 to April 29, 2020 in the National Capital Region. (You will arrive in Ottawa on Saturday, April 25, 2020).

The Rotary Adventure in Citizenship Program, now in its 70th year, provides a unique opportunity for participants to meet their peers from every part of Canada and to discuss and debate with them issues facing Canada today. It also gives participants the opportunity to see "behind-the-scenes" at many of our National institutions, an opportunity that is usually not available to either visitors or residents of the National Capital Region. A unique component of the program is the billeting of participants with host families. The participants can expect to return home tired, thrilled by the experience, with many new friends, and often with their assumptions about Canada significantly changed.

The Rotary Adventure in Citizenship Program is organized and managed by volunteer members of the Rotary Club of Ottawa. Our Club, participating agencies, and the host families, take very seriously our responsibilities to the participants in the program during their visit to the National Capital Region. In its history no participant has suffered a serious accident or injury. However, participants and their families must understand and accept that there is always a risk of accidental injury or other unfortunate incident that can occur. The Club, its members, the participating agencies and the host families will not be expected to bear liability should such an accident or incident take place. In order to minimize risks the participants must refrain from conduct that could jeopardize their own well-being or the well-being of others.

While on the program, participants are not permitted:

- To vape or to smoke or purchase cigarettes or cannabis
- To drink or purchase alcohol,
- To drive any kind of motorized vehicle at any time

Attached are a Parental and Participant Consent forms. Please complete and sign the forms and return it to your sponsoring Rotary Club for delivery to us. The delivery of the signed forms is required to enroll the participant in the program.

Finally, let me add a word regarding the time the participants will be spending with their host family. They will be a guest of a family that shares our commitment to the program and who have volunteered to provide meals, a place to sleep and transportation to and from program events. A token gift and a note of thanks to the family is always appreciated. Each Host Family has been properly vetted by the Rotary Club of Ottawa. There will always be two or more participants placed with each Host Family. Their names and contact information will be provided to the participant prior to the program.
